Flaming Silver		A small plant with red young foliage showing no variegation, soon developing to silvery margins.
Forest Flame		A larger hardy shrub with bright red young shoots. The leaves pass through red to pink, cream to green. Flowers in large terminal, drooping pinacles.
Little Heath		
Little Heath Green		
Mountain Fire		The shoots are red, turning to deep chestnut brown. This variety is vigorous and produces a good plant in a year if necessary.
Valley Valentine		Flowers deep red, hardly fading at all. The foliage is dark green. The flower is one of the best in the whole Pieris range.
